Around the World 8. 10. 2024 – 20. 4. 2025

Thanks to this interactive exhibition inspired by the famous novel Around the World in 80 Days by Jules Verne, the visitors will travel back in time to the early days of the 20th century and embark on exciting adventures in faraway lands. Just like the book's main protagonist, Phileas Fogg, visitors must accept a bet and travel the world in 80 days. This unique exhibition offers visitors insight into many captivating and remote worlds and the opportunity to solve tasks and go on quests. Their task will be to successfully pass through nine different environments symbolising different places from all over the world – from the Italian town of Venice, the Middle-Eastern bazaars, the African savannah, India, the South American jungle, to the frosty Arctic landscape. In each environment, the visitors must solve a task to earn a clue for their passport, and at the end of the journey, they will discover the treasure of Phileas Fogg.

The exhibition introduces an original concept that merges an interactive light exhibition with elements of an escape room and treasure hunt games. The exhibition is the joint work of the DEPO2015 creative team from Pilsen, Czech Republic.

BIBIANA offers guided introductions with a lecturer for the AROUND THE WORLD EXHIBITION for schools and organised groups. The introductions will be held on the hour, from 09:00 to 13:00, and require a reservation. /For groups of max. 30 children/.

Individuals may enter the exhibition in 15-minute intervals, with a maximum capacity of 10 persons per time slot. On school days, entry may be restricted due to organised school groups. Individual visitors are advised to use the afternoon hours or on weekends to avoid any delays due to restrictions. Last entry is 60 minutes before the closing hour.

Serbian illustrators 6. 3. – 20. 4. 2025

The exhibition showcases the works of a group of current Serbian illustrators, titled Illustrations Date, located in Belgrade. They have been meeting since 2018 to share experiences and inspire each other without commercial benefits. The group has grown to be a safe space for artistic growth and the exchange of ideas and support of professionals. Illustrations are presented not only as art but as a way of life that defies the superficiality of modern popular culture. The collection of artworks reflects the authors' personal projects and contributes to developing a global illustrator scene.

A Journey Through the Land of Tales 7. 11. 2024 – 2. 3. 2025

This exhibition showcases the creations of noted Slovak artists whose art shaped the visual appearance of the most popular TV stories and tales. Visitors will have the opportunity to discover original illustrations and designs of the many little bedtime stories called Večerníček and the many tales for children broadcasted by Slovak Television.

The exhibition highlights the role of the artists who created the unforgettable characters, scenes, and visual worlds that whole generations of kids grew to love and are now considered iconic among the Slovak productions for children.
